

Restored Order Enrollment & Class Dates 2010-2011

Participation in this program allows 2nd graders and older students (of same family) who **have not received First Eucharist**, to receive Confirmation and Eucharist at the same celebration.

Available to a limited number of families who are:

- Practicing Catholics who are registered at St. Philip
- Attending Mass regularly
- Attending RE for the current school year
- Have a child 2nd grade or older preparing for Eucharist for the first time
- **Note:** Older siblings in these families are welcome to participate and prepare for the sacrament of Confirmation
- The Restored Order fee is \$30.00 per student

Families participate in five classes, attend a mandatory Sacramental Prep meeting, Parent Enrollment meeting, and the retreat. These classes are in addition to regular Religious Education classes, **and at least one parent/guardian must attend each class with the student.**

- Children will prepare for sacraments
- Parents will be instructed in adult level classes to help their children
- Families should be involved in service to others
